## Non-Injection Neuromuscular Rehabilitation

FDA-cleared adjunctive therapy for muscle spasm, weakness, and limited ROM — billed on lien

NuThera offers EmSculpt Neo functional rehabilitation — a high-intensity focused electromagnetic (HIFEM) and radiofrequency modality FDA-cleared (October 2024) for neuromuscular rehab. Use it when patients refuse, fail, or are not candidates for ESI or surgery.

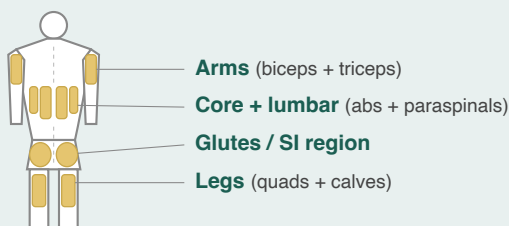
### WHEN TO REFER

- **MVA / soft-tissue injury** — lumbar strain or extremity injury with muscle spasm or weakness
- **Failed conservative PT** — plateaued patients still in pain after 4–6 weeks of standard PT
- **Informed refusal of ESI / surgery** — patient declines injection or operative options after shared decision-making
- **Pre-surgical optimization** — strengthen core stabilizers before lumbar spine or extremity surgery
- **Post-surgical rehab** — rebuild atrophied muscles after immobilization or surgery
- **Lumbar radiculopathy with weakness** — documented motor deficit needing neuromuscular re-education
- **Workplace / OWCP cases** — conservative care documentation strengthens claim file

### DOCUMENTATION FOR THE CASE FILE

- **Initial evaluation report** — physician-authored, with mechanism-of-injury narrative
- **Treatment session notes** — objective measurements, ROM, pain, functional progress
- **Causation language** — treatment necessity tied directly to the subject incident
- **Informed refusal record** — shared decision-making documented to counter failure-to-mitigate claims
- **Itemized superbill** — diagnosis-linked, defensible at lien negotiation
- **Records turnaround** — subpoena-ready records released within 24–48 hours

### BILLING & LIEN TERMS

- **Lien-based billing** — no upfront cost to patient; attorney protected
- **Standard rehab framework** — billed under physical medicine and rehabilitation
- **Reasonable & customary rates** — see NuThera Provider Fee Schedule
- **Reduction discussions** — we negotiate in good faith at settlement
- **LOP friendly** — Letters of Protection accepted from established firms

### SCHEDULING & OPERATIONS

- **New patient intake** — in-person at either location or telemed initial consult, within 24–48 hours
- **Multilingual support** — English, Spanish, and Tagalog at the front office
- **Multi-modal under one roof** — physician, PT, DME, and EmSculpt Neo coordinated
- **Treatment protocol** — 4–8 sessions, 30 min each, over 3–4 weeks
- **Tolerability** — no anesthesia, no downtime; patients complete the protocol
